

RESOLUTION
OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE
SANTA BARBARA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

TO ESTABLISH THE JAMES D. SCHEINFELD ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND BUSINESS
INNOVATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, James D. Scheinfeld has been a steadfast supporter of Santa Barbara City College as a member of the Board of the Foundation for SBCC since 1989, chaired the 21st Century campaign from 1990 - 1996, raising more than \$25 million for College programs and facilities, and served as chair of the Foundation Board from 1996 to 2000;


WHEREAS, he has been a generous contributor to the College with gifts totaling in excess of \$2.3 million which have bolstered numerous academic programs and student services;

WHEREAS, in 1990 James D. Scheinfeld named the Foundation for Santa Barbara City College as a beneficiary of the Sylvia R. Scheinfeld Charitable Remainder Unitrust, the proceeds of which will be used to establish a permanent endowment to support the Entrepreneurship and Business Innovation Program at Santa Barbara City College (EBIP). The purpose of the EBIP is to encourage and support the development of new businesses, promote entrepreneurship and assist existing businesses in Santa Barbara grow through a combination of credit and noncredit courses, seminars, workshops and individual business consulting;


WHEREAS, his giving to the College is motivated by a genuine regard and commitment to equal access to educational opportunity for all individuals and because his generosity and thoughtfulness have inspired students, faculty, staff and community leaders.

THEREFORE, it is resolved; the Board of Trustees of the Santa Barbara City College District recognizes James D. Scheinfeld and expresses its deepest appreciation and affection by authorizing the naming of the Entrepreneurship and Business Innovation Program as the James D. Scheinfeld Entrepreneurship and Business Innovation Program.




